We respect children's rights

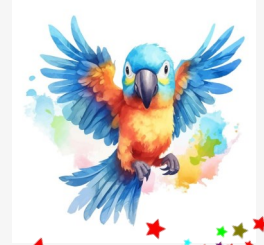
Article 3: The best interests of the child must be a top priority in all decisions and actions that affect children.
