Sports Grant Spending at Ashgate Specialist Support Primary School 2024-2025

We have received £17323.00 in Sports Grant for 2024-2025

Our priorities for spending our sports grant this year aim to fulfil the following:

- the engagement of <u>all</u> pupils in regular physical activity kick-starting healthy active lifestyles
- the profile of PE and sport being raised across the school as a tool for whole school improvement
- increased confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
- broader experience of a range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
- increased participation in competitive sport

We understand that the Sports Grant may be time limited and we need to ensure that we can sustain a high level of PE and Physical Activity without relying financially on the grant. In order to do this we maintain self sustainability through the training of our own staff so that we can continue to deliver appropriate activities without the reliance on additional funding. We have developed a PE Curriculum and policy specifically for Ashgate pupils which will support teachers to maintain a high level of teaching and learning across the school.

We are also committed to identifying those gaps in children's learning for those who are eligible for Pupil Premium. In the event of the Sports Grant ending we would continue to bridge these gaps through Pupil Premium spending.
