Governments must respect the rights and responsibilities of parents to guide their child as they grow up.



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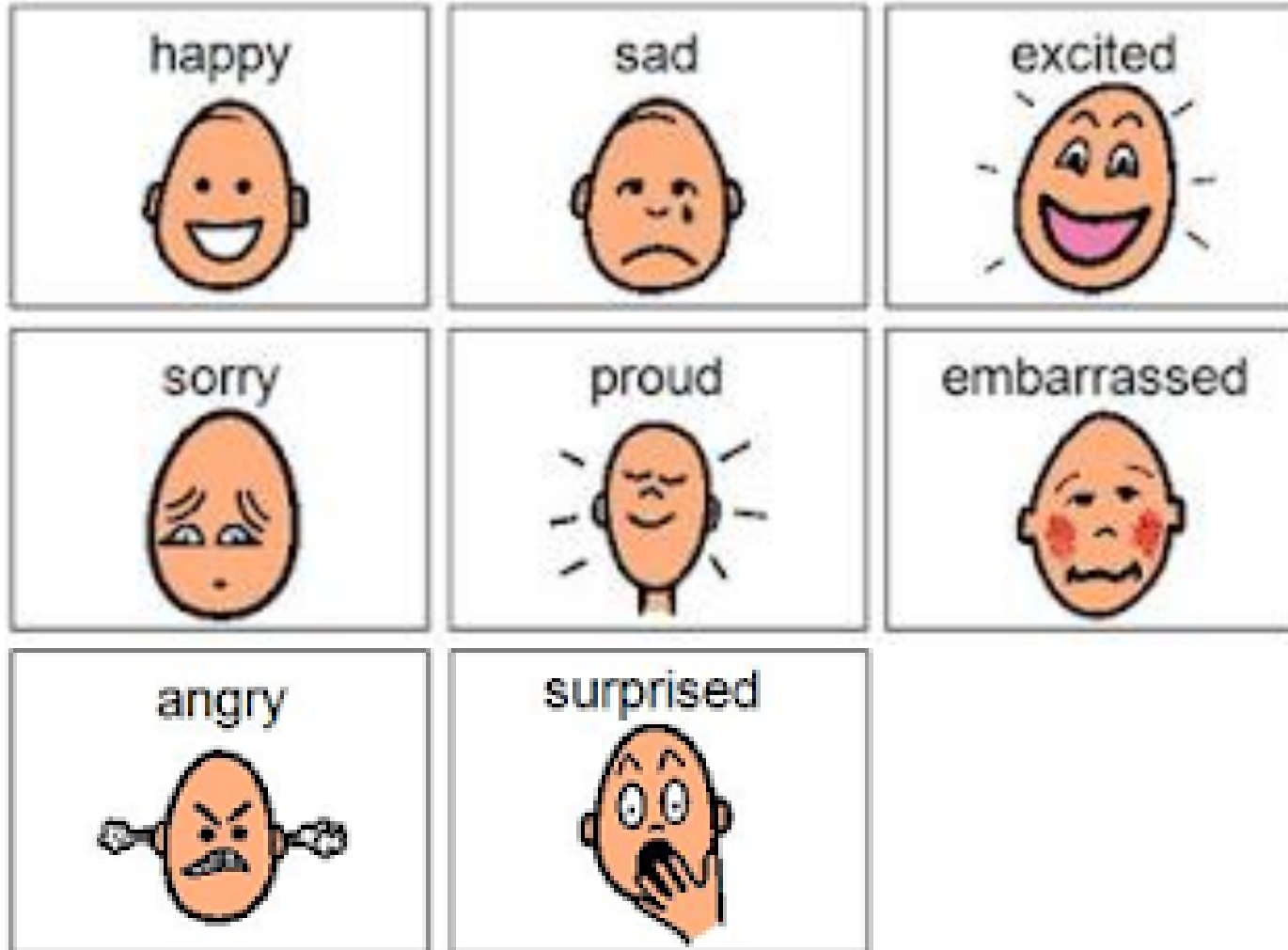
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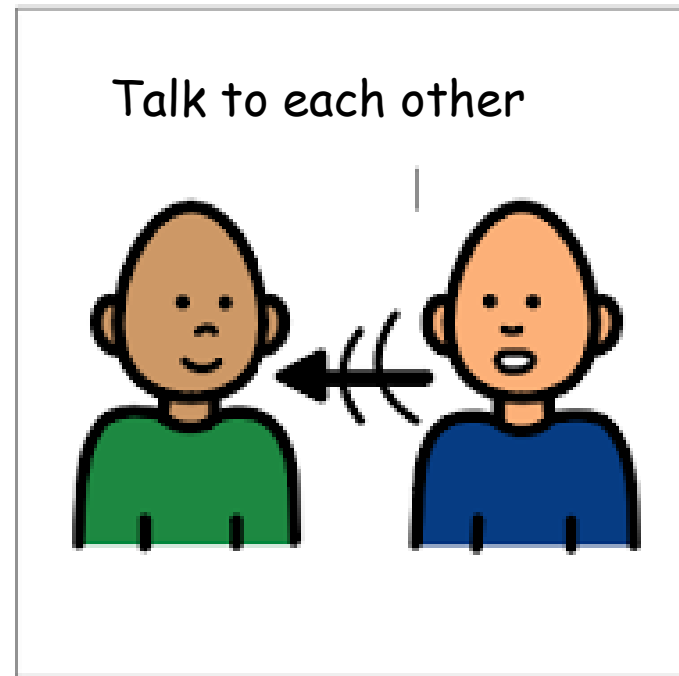

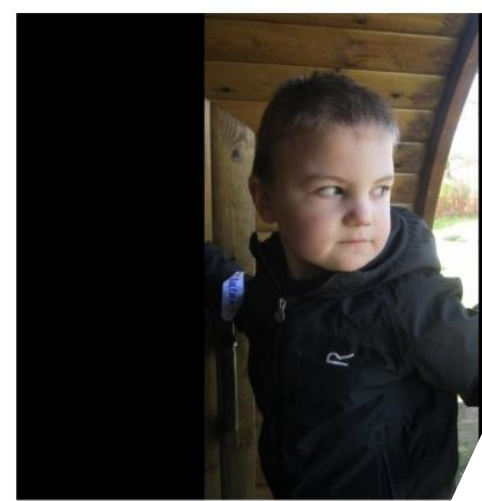
Little one, whoever you are,

yours.






Whoever they are,

same.



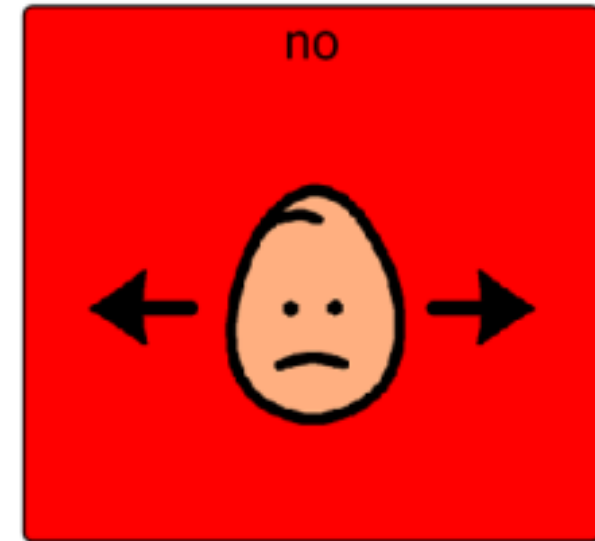
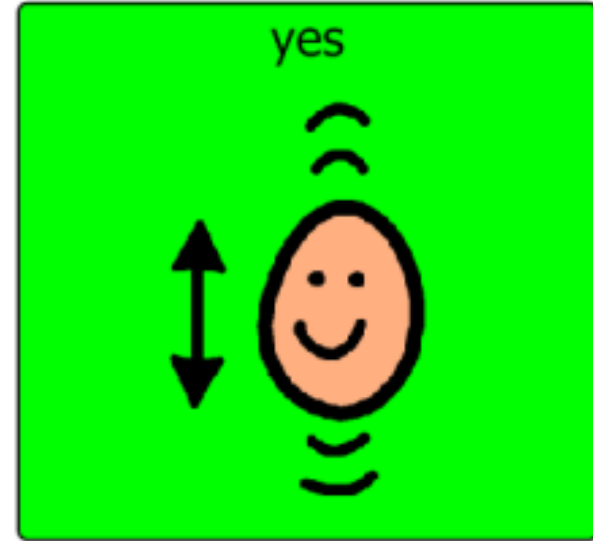
